Be a daily Bible reader in 2011!

Sign-up for DBR

The Daily Bible Reading (DBR) ministry is for those individuals or families who would like to be encouraged and to encourage others in our daily Bible reading.

There are 4 daily Bible reading schedules within the ministry:

- ◆ Track 1 - read NT during 2011
- ◆ Track 2 - read OT and NT during 2011 and 2012; or continue with 2010 and 2011
- ◆ Track 3 - read the OT and NT during 2011 with The Daily Bible
- ◆ Track 4 - use your own Bible reading schedule

Track 1 and Track 2 schedules will be placed on a table in the south hallway beginning December 5.

The Daily Bible is in the New International Version and includes devotional insights to guide you through God's word. This Bible provides 365 daily readings based on the events of the Bible in chronological order as constructed by F. Lagard Smith. The historical arrangement of every book of the Bible is helpful in understanding which events occurred near the same time-frame. Also, The Daily Bible has several topical arrangements for the books of Proverbs and Ecclesiastes. Also, for anyone who follows another schedule to read the Bible on a daily basis we would like you to join our effort to encourage each other.

All members or visitors to the congregation are welcome to join us in our daily reading of the Bible.

Periodically, we meet prior to the Sunday evening services to read the daily passages together and are planning another kickoff luncheon after the morning worship services in early January.
